- ♣ There will be at least 2 jury members to evaluate for each Division.
- ♣ Judging Criteria: Adjudication will be based on the overall performance of the competitors, and the following aspects: Technique, Interpretation, Musicality and Artistic Appeal. The decision of the adjudicators on all results and artistic matters shall be final.

Registration Rules and Regulations

- 1. The competition is open to all nationalities. Please attach a photocopy of your IC (for Malaysians) or passport (for non-Malaysians) for verification.
- 2. Participants are allowed to apply for more than **ONE** category but are **NOT** allowed to participate in different divisions of the same category.
- 3. NO NEED to prepare the SCORES
- 4. All pieces must be played WITHOUT REPEATS, except for D.C. and/or D.S.
- 5. The panel of the jury has the right to terminate a performance at any time of the competition, should they feel the need to do so. The decisions and results of the competition made by the jury are final and indisputable.
- 6. The organizer reserves the right to disqualify participants who failed to meet the requirements of the competition, or anyone who violated the regulations.
- 7. Entry fees are not transferable or refundable.
- 8. Incomplete entry forms, including payment of entry fees or the required supporting materials, are all deemed as invalid.
- 9. People(s) or parties without authorization from the organizer are **NOT ALLOWED TO TAKE PHOTOS**, **VIDEOS AND/OR MAKE ANY KIND OF RECORDINGS AT ANY SESSION OR STAGE THROUGHOUT THE COMPETITION.** The copyrights of all audio and visual recordings during the competition are the sole properties of the competition and organizer.

- 11. GRAND PIANO will be provided for the competition.
